What are these tests?

iReady: The i-Ready Diagnostic is a personalized test for teachers, adapting questions based on student responses. It helps create a tailored path of instruction. The test gets progressively harder until a student answers incorrectly, pinpointing areas needing support. Wilmot Union High School administers this test to mainly 9th graders and uses this test and its data to determine placement, adjustments to instruction, and possible academic interventions.

Access: Federal and state laws mandate annual assessments for English Learners (ELs) to gauge English language proficiency. The ACCESS for ELLs assessment aligns with WIDA Consortium's ELD Standards, crucial for instructing and testing ELs, including those with significant cognitive disabilities under IDEA.

PreACT Secure: A summative assessment for 9th and 10th graders, aligned to ACT standards. It mirrors the ACT in structure, scoring, and reporting, predicting ACT performance in 11th grade and college readiness. An online assessment.

ACT: Wisconsin 11th graders take the ACT. Administered in-person, scores aid in college admissions, scholarships, course placement, and NCAA eligibility. Accommodations and EL supports available in both paper and online formats.

Forward: The Wisconsin Forward Exam assesses students online, aligning with state academic standards. Administered in spring, it evaluates 10th grade students in social studies. Accommodations and supports ensure accurate measurement of student progress.

DLM: The DLM assessment gauges academic progress online for students with significant cognitive disabilities. Subjects include ELA, mathematics, science, and social studies. The system maps learning throughout the year, aligning with Wisconsin Essential Elements and Academic Standards.

AP Exams: AP Exams are standardized exams designed to measure how well students have mastered the content and skills of a specific AP course. Most AP courses have an end-of-year exam, but a few courses have different ways to assess what you've learned—for example, AP Art and Design students submit a portfolio of work for scoring.
