Good afternoon,

We are so excited to have our students back in the building! Thank you for your cooperation and flexibility during our transition to fourteen days of all-virtual instruction. We are pleased with how well the transition went and how engaged our students and staff were during this process. As of today, we have resumed our [4 & 1 schedule](#). Here are a few updates/helpful reminders for next week:

1. **Parent/Teacher Conferences:** In lieu of scheduled evening in-person conferences, we are asking parents to contact specific teachers to request a phone call or Google Meet. Teachers do have scheduled office hours from 1:15 to-3:20 pm each Wednesday. Please work with the teacher to schedule a time that works for both of you. This could include time outside of designated office hours. Teachers and parents can also initiate a requested conference at any time. We want to encourage open communication when it is necessary and not be waiting for a scheduled night in order to share information, concerns, and problem-solve with parents.
2. **Under Construction:** Wilmot Union High School will be having concrete work done on the northeast side of the building beginning on Wednesday, October 14. The work will occur on Wednesdays and Saturdays when students are not present. Please note that a safety barricade will be up during the demolition and construction process.
3. **Face-Coverings:** Remind your student to properly wear their face-covering over their mouth and nose. Also, please inform your student that Wilmot's face-covering requirement is different from the state face-covering mandate. Though the state mandate may have a set expiration date, Wilmot's face-covering requirement does not. **Face-covering requirements at Wilmot Union High School are based on school board action and will not end until the board takes action to do so.**
4. **Illness Screening at Home:** Parents are encouraged to screen their students daily before school for symptoms of illness. Please see the [PARENT Guidance and Daily Checklist](#). **If your child is not feeling well, do not send them to school.** Contact the high school office as soon as possible (To report an absence, call the High School Office Attendance Hotline at 262-862-2351, ext. 500 or email attendance@wilmoths.k12.wi.us). When calling, notify the office of your child's symptoms. If an absence is due to quarantine, please indicate that as well.

5. **COVID-19 Dashboard:** In an effort to keep everyone up to date regarding COVID-19, we have created a COVID-19 Dashboard. This dashboard can be found on our website (<https://www.wilmothighschool.com/covid-19-dashboard.cfm>) and includes the number of current positive cases, as well as, the current number of students and staff quarantined.
