

Parent Engagement and Student Success

Children with engaged parents are more likely to:

- Earn higher grades or test scores
- Graduate from high school and attend post-secondary education
- Develop self-confidence and motivation in the classroom
- Have better social skills and classroom behavior

They are also less likely to:

- Have low self-esteem
- Need redirection in the classroom
- Develop behavioral issues

"A school striving for family involvement often leads with its mouth—identifying projects, needs, and goals and then telling parents how they can contribute. A school striving for parent engagement, on the other hand, tends to lead with its ears—listening to what parents think, dream, and worry about."

- 1. Create a system for feedback from families
- 2. Hold monthly meetings with specific focus
- 3. Establish questions for follow up survey
- Return to leadership with specific ideas for action &/or questions to be answered
