### **Academic Excellence and Student Growth**

We've achieved the **highest 4-year graduation rate on record**, a truly inspiring milestone that speaks volumes about our collective efforts to support every student's journey.

This spring, our students showcased their incredible growth as ACT scores reached the highest composite average since 2021-22. This significant improvement demonstrates the effectiveness of our instructional practices and our sharp focus on academic excellence. We've also seen a large increase in the number of students taking AP classes and the total number of AP tests taken, signifying a growing pursuit of advanced learning and challenging coursework. Our academic prowess isn't just about test scores; our Academic Decathlon (AcaDec) team continues to dominate, once again clinching the state championship!

Furthermore, Wilmot has earned a statewide reputation as **a leader in secondary-level standards-based grading**. This recognition highlights our innovative spirit and willingness to embrace new approaches to teaching and learning that truly benefit our students.

### A Nurturing and Engaging School Environment

Beyond academics, the positive transformation in our school climate has been truly heartwarming. **Discipline referrals have decreased dramatically** over the last few years, a clear reflection of our collective dedication to creating a positive, safe, and supportive learning environment where every student feels valued.







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### 2025 PSAT/NMSQT Test Information

### **Attention Sophomore Students & Families:**

Students in the Class of 2027 have the opportunity to take the 2025 PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) this fall.

This OPTIONAL test measures critical thinking skills that are essential for success in college, including critical reading, math problem-solving, and writing skills.

The 2025 PSAT/NMSQT is also the qualifying test students must take to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) competitions for college scholarships that will be awarded in 2027.

### Who Typically Takes the PSAT?

- Students planning to take the SAT
- Students who score very high on standardized tests
- Students whose parent is employed by a company participating in the NMSC

### Test Details

- 1 Location: Wilmot Union High School
- Toate: Wednesday, October 15, 2025
- √ Time: 7:30 a.m.
- Format: Digital test students must bring a fully charged Chromebook
- Duration: Approximately 3 hours
- \$ Cost: \$18.00 (payable by cash, check, or credit card via Skyward). Make checks payable to Wilmot Union High School.

### Registration:

 To register, complete the <u>2025 PSAT/NMSQT Registration Form</u> and submit your \$18.00 payment by June 6, 2025. Payment options are detailed on the registration form.

If you're unsure whether your student should take the PSAT, please contact their school counselor to discuss if it's the right fit.
