Spotlight on a Classroom:

American Sign Language 3 with Ms Youra

- Students dove into a video escape room, decoding signed clues on Chromebooks while working solo or with a partner. Clear directions and posted learning targets let everyone begin right away and stay focused, and Ms Youra's steady circulation with quick checks kept momentum high. Engagement was easy to see as students leaned in, signed with peers to compare answers, and celebrated small wins. Their growth is clear as they apply new vocabulary and grammar in fresh contexts, read signs more quickly, and self-correct with minimal prompting, which reflects thoughtful planning and strong routines that supported a smooth, well-paced lesson from bell to bell.

Quick Tech Tip for Families

- Use your phone as a scanner to send clear PDFs of forms and student work. On iPhone open Notes and choose Scan Documents. On Android open Google Drive and choose Scan. Save with a smart name so teachers can find it fast, for example JordanLee Biology Oct 30 2025. Then email it to the teacher or upload to Otus if requested. This works great for permission slips, AP forms, math work that needs clean images, and any signed documents.

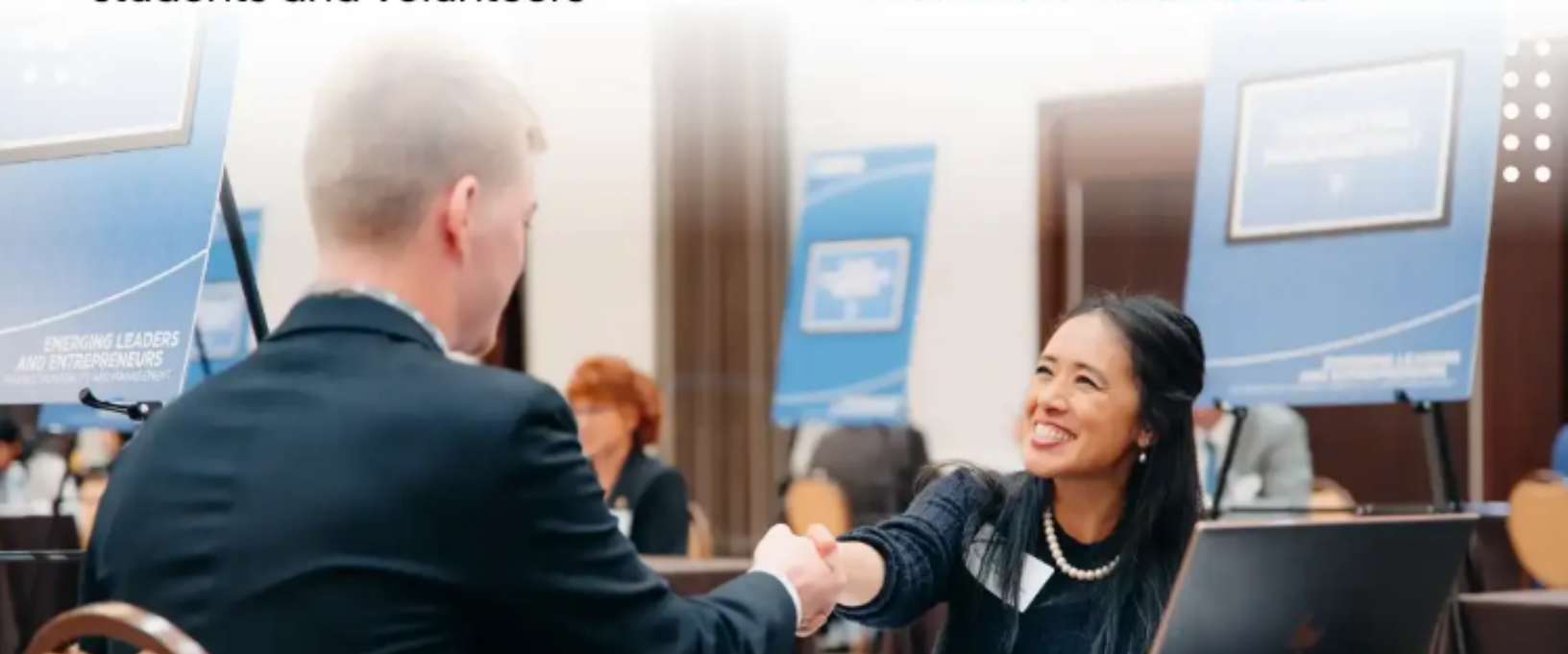

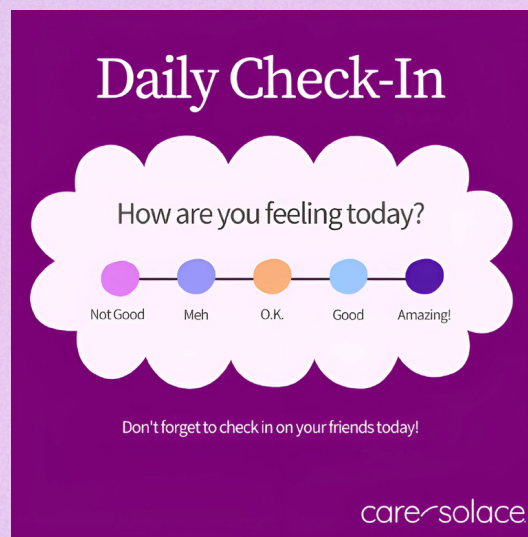

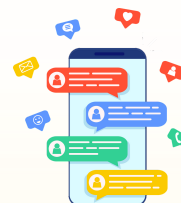
