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# A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL:

## 'FRESHMEN ONLY' DAY GIVES NEW PANTHERS A SNEAK PEEK OF HIGH SCHOOL!

Winding through a maze of locker-lined hallways can make for a daunting first day of high school for any student making the transition from middle school. Wilmot Union High School hopes to quell some of those nervous feelings and fears with a day **just** for our incoming 9th graders.

On **August 31st**, administrators and teachers will open the doors to the class of 2027 in a school-spirit driven day that shows incoming students all Wilmot has to offer. In addition to abbreviated class periods, so that students can walk through their course schedule and meet their teachers, the orientation day will also feature full school tours and a pep rally with the entire freshmen class assembled in the fieldhouse.

First year students will be guided by our upperclassmen leaders who will share their own experiences during their first weeks of high school. The lineup of activities throughout the day are intended to create structure for students, particularly those feeling overwhelmed on a day when everyone is typically running at 100 miles per hour.

## WUHS ATHLETIC REGISTRATION

**ATHLETIC REGISTRATION MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE THROUGH THE  
WILMOT UNION HIGH SCHOOL WEBSITE.**

Steps for Online Registration

1. Click on the Menu tab located at the top of the homepage.
2. Choose Athletic/Activity on tool bar then click on Athletic Registration.
3. Select New Users-Creat an Account or Returning Users-Login Here.
4. Once you have logged into your account you may start the registration form by selecting Register (highlighted blue) then register new student or select your students name.
5. The physical clearance form can be downloaded during the registration process or a hard copy handed into the athletic office.
6. Complete the on-line registration process and pay the \$60.00 athletic registration fee per sport. (Family maximum of \$180.00 per year)
7. Once you complete these steps, you are registered and may participate in Wilmot Union High School Athletics.

Physical Examination


The physical exam form (clearance form) needs to be taken to your physician for signature and date. This is the only form that will be handed into the athletic office. This form is available in the athletic office or under the "Other Forms" tab on the Athletic Registration.

- **Step 1 - My Account:** Enter all information requested to receive the Event Reminders via email or text.
- **Step 2 - Choose Activities:** Select the activities that you want to keep track of and mark the checkboxes next to them. When finished, click the 'Continue to Next Step' button.

**A. Categories List:** This list lets you filter the Activities per categories. These categories are related to the School-Only Events displayed on the right side of the screen.

**B. Conference/Non-Conference Events:** Select the Competitive and Non-Competitive events of your interest.

- **Step 3 - Setup Notification Preferences:** Setup how many hours/days in advance you want to be reminded about the event. You can also be notified about any changes made to the event schedule by selecting the option 'Schedule Changes Notifications' for every activity in the list, and then clicking 'Save My Settings'. These setups can be changed at any time upon logging in to your account or by reaching out to the Athletics & Activities Office.

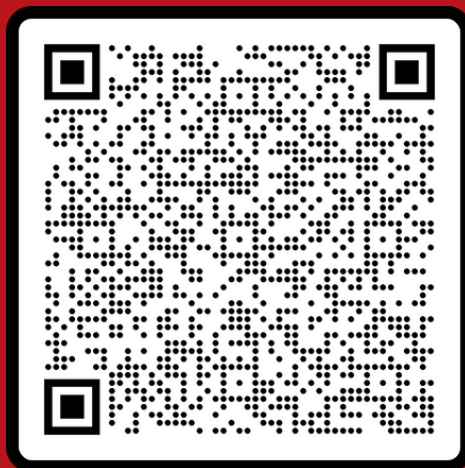

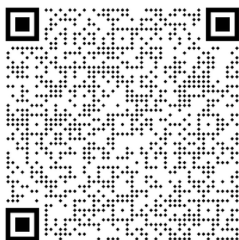

Dear Wilmot Families:

We hope that you are having an enjoyable summer and look forward to seeing you in the fall. Our required annual on-line registration is now open. This service is available on Family Access, which means your Family Access log-in and password are required. You **cannot** complete the on-line registration process using your child's Student Access log-in and password. If you need your log-in and password, contact the High School Office at 862-2351. The registration process will take you and your student approximately fifteen minutes to complete. *Note: You will need to disable pop-up blockers in order to log in to Skyward.* Upon completion of your on-line registration, your child will be registered for the new school year.

The on-line steps will address the following:

- **Update demographics, which includes address, phone number, email address, emergency contact and health related information;**
- **Enroll in School Messenger Text Notifications (optional);**
- **Pre-order a yearbook from Jostens (optional);**
- **Pre-order your students school pictures from Network Photography (optional);**
- **Review and acknowledge that you and your student have read the 2023-24 Student Handbook, 1:1 Chromebook Handbook and Emergency Consent Statement;**
- **Free/Reduced Lunch Application (optional) – a new application needs to be completed every year**

Your student's most current schedule will be available for viewing after online registration is complete. *Schedules are still subject to change prior to the start of school.* Please review the schedule and if you have any questions or concerns, email your student's counselor. WTMJ Channel 4, FOX Channel 6, WISN Channel 12 and WDJT Channel 58

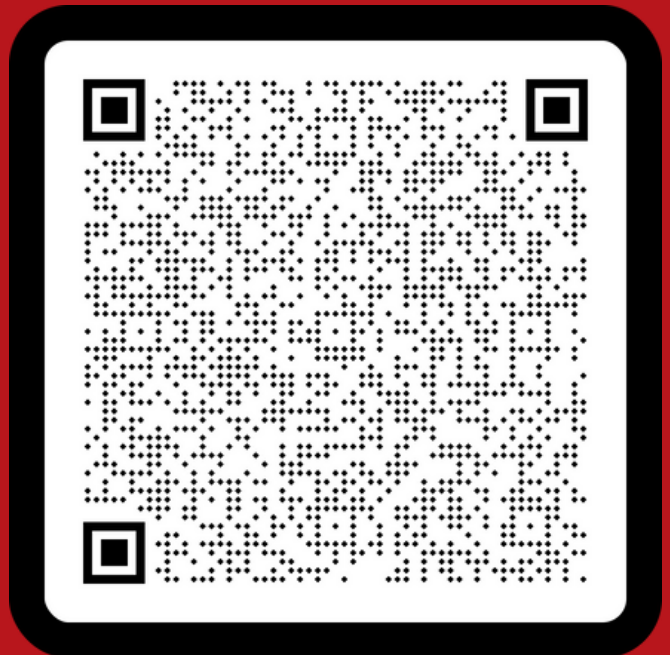
