# **GENERAL UPDATES/REMINDERS:**

- Summer Chromebook Usage and Repair: During the summer months when school is not in session, we urge students to utilize their Chromebooks to keep the device up to date. The devices take updates from Google at least once a month, and sometimes more often. As you use the Chromebook for continued learning and discovery, the device will automatically update and notify users that the device needs to be rebooted for the update to be applied. If you are in need of repair for your Chromebook, please bring the device to the high school office during normal business hours. Check your device often during the summer to be sure that it is in good working order with a functional keyboard, trackpad, wireless connectivity, and clear screen. Plan ahead to be ready for the beginning of the 2022-23 school year. Be aware that if you choose to wait until school begins in the fall, that the device will be unavailable for use for an extended period of time due to the overwhelming demand for service and repair.

## **STUDENT SERVICES:**

PSAT Information: Please see the below information regarding the optional PSAT/NMSQT test.

Students in the class of 2024 have the option to take the 2022 PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) this fall. The PSAT/NMSQT measures critical-

-thinking skills that are important for success in college, including critical reading, math problem-solving, and writing skills. The 2022 PSAT/NMSQT is also the qualifying test students must take to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) competitions for college scholarships that will be awarded in 2024.

The PSAT Test is typically taken by students:

- \* Who are planning on taking the SAT test
- \* Score very high on standardized tests
- \* Have a parent that is employed by a company that takes part in the NMSC

The test will be administered at Wilmot Union High School on Wednesday, October 12, 2022. The test is approximately four hours in length and will be administered in person during a block school day at Wilmot Union High School. There is an \$18.00 fee to take the test which is payable by cash, credit card via Skyward or by check. Checks should be made payable to Wilmot Union High School.

To register for the 2022 PSAT/NMSQT test please complete this form and submit your \$18.00 payment through one of the options listed on the form by June 8, 2022. If you are not sure if your student should take the PSAT, please discuss it with your school counselor.
