ACADEMICS:

- AP Test Information: Important AP test information has been posted on Skyward Family and Student Access and emailed to parents and students. Please check both on a regular basis so that you have all of the information necessary in order to participate in AP testing this year.
- 22-23 Course Selection is complete: Every student has had the opportunity to meet individually
 with their school counselor to discuss their course selection for next year. Each student was
 given a reminder about the June 1, 2022 deadline to make changes to these courses. You can
 see your student's course selection in Skyward under "Schedule," then "Course Requests." As
 always, if you have any questions, please reach out to your student's school counselor.



- Quarantined Students: If a student is quarantined this year, parents/guardians can expect the following process to be followed:
 - An Associate Principal will call families with the next steps.
 - The student's counselor will email all of the teachers and include the student & parent(s)/guardian(s) on the email to indicate the length of absence. This email is to ensure that all parties have each other's contact information to help the student continue to engage in school remotely.
 - Students will be required to complete a daily check-in form emailed each day of quarantine from Ms. Cates. Ms. Cates will help to facilitate any communication and/or connections that students may need with their teachers. If a student does not complete the form for two consecutive school days, someone from Wilmot Union High School will reach out to help problem-solve.
 - Students will need to check the Google Classroom assigned to each of their courses on a
 daily basis for updates, assignments, and class resources. They should contact the
 teacher directly with specific questions. For information on Google classroom and

 - Students who are returning from quarantine may be entered into a guided study hall.
 When their make-up work from quarantine is complete, they will return to their regular study hall.
