2019/2020 Panther Educational Assistant Program Application

The Panther Educational Assistant Programs are designed to offer juniors and seniors an opportunity to work closely with a faculty member, students and other WUHS school personnel. **Students participating in any of the programs are limited to participation in only one period of their school day and must be in addition to their 6 classes.** The only exception to the above statement is a student who is doing peer tutoring. Also, in order to be eligible a student must do the following:

- Students must be on course to graduate with their graduating class.
- Students must have 11 credits after their sophomore year or 17 credits after their junior year.
- Students, who fail any class at the end of the first, second, or third-quarter, during the present school year, will be reviewed and possibly removed, from the Panther Educational Assistant Program.
- Students must have passed all classes the previous semester.
- Students enrolled in the Panther Educational Assistant Program cannot have had any truanicies, assigned to the STEP room, out of school suspensions during their present or previous semester.
- All Panther Educational Assistant Program applications must be turned in within the **first five days of each semester** unless an extension is approved by the Principal of Wilmot Union High School.

PEER TUTOR

Students can receive a ¼ credit per semester for tutoring. Enrollment into this program requires a teacher and school counselor approval.

OFFICE ASSISTANT

Students can receive a ¼ credit per semester for serving as an office assistant in the High School Office, the Office of Student Services or the District Office. Possible duties may include: office runners, filing, sorting, etc. Enrollment into this program requires office personnel and school counselor approval.

TEACHER ASSISTANT

Students can receive a ¼ credit per semester as a teacher assistant. This program is designed for but not limited to the following departments: P.E., Tech. Ed., Family and Consumer Education, Band, School Store (The Paw), or another lab based class.

IT ASSISTANT

Students can receive a ¼ credit per semester as a teacher assistant. Assist the IT Department with end user support, pc repairs and setup, tracking AV equipment and any other needs of the department. Enrollment into this program requires approval of the IT Department.

Please Note: In order to maintain accurate attendance, all students must remain in their assigned study hall until the application is approved and a new schedule is received.
